※ Home Safety Promotion Project for the Elderly -

- 1) Call for county government to support handrails installation for senior citizens who have low-income or who live alone. In 2009, 110 handrails were installed while 120

were set up in 2010.

- 2) Organize Fall-Prevention Class for the Elderly with community development association. 35 people have participated in the class so far and their related knowledge was improved from 22% to 41% after examination.

※ Farm Safety Promotion Project-

Organize Training Camp on Farm Safety Promotion in cooperation with trainees from fruit trees and bamboo products marketing class. After examination, trainee's knowledge on agriculture safety improved from 44% to 76%.

※ Improvement Project on Campus Safety

- 1) 2 additional schools started to organize Safety Training Camp; safety check results shows that students' bikes for commute was 100% qualified.
- 2) Raise public awareness on Drowning Prevention in cooperation with county fire department to enhance students' knowledge on water safety; after examination, students' knowledge on this is improved from 82% to 96%.

➤ Foreign Spouse-

- \* Organize household environmental safety check in 80 homes where there are senior citizens over 65 years old or children under 6. The result shows that 92.5% home safety environment is improved.
- \* Hold 4 symposiums on Home Safety Environment and result shows that participants' awareness on home safety is improved from 46% to 60%.

➤ Traffic Environment –

- \* 8 high-risk traffic environment were inspected while 7 of them were improved.
- \* Improve unsafe traffic environment by implementing reflective mirrors in 48 places and Y-shape reflective mirrors in 16 places.

### Criteria 4– Injury data

7: Over the past 12 months, have you analyzed any injury/crime data? Yes

- \* 200 questionnaires for home safety environment; among them, 120 were issued to families with senior citizens above 65 years old while the rest were issued to families with children under 6.
- \* Records of 128 community injury cases while 39 of them happened to senior citizens above 65, 26 to children under 6, and 63 to general public.

The analysis of above questionnaires and injury records shows that citizens above 65 are prone to get injury in bathroom, sidewalk and rooms at home, thus organize Home Safety Promotion Project for the Elderly.

- \* 844 car incidents reported to police stations.
- \* 6452 injury cases reported to school health center.
- \* 19 injury deaths according to Household Registration Office.

### Final comments:

10: Over the past 12 months, what have been some of the biggest challenges to your ISC and what steps have you taken to address these?

The suicide rate of Dongshan Township has been the highest among the whole county and the victims were mainly middle aged. In order to prevent this, suicide prevention project is still in process in high-risk villages.

11: Over the past 12 months, what have been some of the biggest opportunities for your ISC and what steps have you taken to sustain them?

- \* Experience exchange and visit with other communities and our progress sharing.
- \* County government sustainably provides fund to improve home environment for senior citizens and to reduce falling injury, which has significant result.
- \* Change new committee chairperson this year in hope of providing new respect in implementing all safe related issues.

Although the process of applying International Safe Community in 2009 was a very hard work, all the residents were gratified with the result. What we should do next is to plan better and more complete safety promotion projects to reduce injury.
