Jinhwa Safe Community Program by Age Group

0-4 years old

- Home environment safety assessment and improvement
- Promote “wearing safety helmet” when take a ride on motorcycle
- Safety education in pre-school

5-14 years

- School environment safety assessment and improvement
- Bike licensing and wearing safety helmet promotion
- Anti-bullying, and anti-drug
- Safe walkway to school and pavement leveling

15-24 years

- Safe community promotion summer camp
 - (1) Communication and exchange of promoting between students and community people
 - (2) Understanding Jinhwa safe community program development
- Life education summer camp: Encouraging students participating in community volunteer service and suicide prevention
- Natural calamities prevention education and training

25-64 years

Home

Safety Promotion and Injury Prevention Program for High-Risk Groups

■ Assisting weak and disabled residents to avoid calamity project

Background: Taiwan is an area full of natural disaster. Jinhwa community's main population aged between 20 and 50, and most of them go to school and work in day time. When calamity happens, the elderly and the weak people need help.

Purpose: To assist weak and disabled residents to avoid calamity rapidly

Start year: 2007

Partners: Community development association, community patrol and guard corps, police office, fire office, South District Office, medical and pharmacy unit, department of social affairs of Tainan City

Methods:

(1) Invite experts to make community's calamity relief map in accordance with local needs.

- (2) List the elderly and disabled in community
- (3) Recruit and organize volunteers to take disaster relief drill

Achievements:

- (1) Set up the community natural calamities prevention and refuge, check and replenish disaster relief supplies and medical articles regularly, and inform evacuation information to each family in the community.
- (2) Link the government’s relieve disaster system to enhance residents the knowledge of disaster prevention, avoiding the calamity and reducing natural disasters.
- (3) There are 23 old or disabled persons in the community, and 24 volunteer members, who are responsible to take care them during the disaster. In addition, there is a reserve to take hands. Disasters prevention volunteers make a home visit to the weak tendency weekly (from Monday to Friday), and take evacuate drill yearly.
