Violence Prevention

Establish cross-unit consulting networks to discuss highly dangerous marital violence cases to jointly set up operation strategies in providing victims necessary protections.

Suicide Prevention

Suicide by burning suicide is a frequent way in Neihu. Suicide prevention posters placed at sections selling charcoal in shopping malls and training cashier staff for adequately providing customers buying charcoal reminders and concerns.

Programs aiming at “High-risk Groups”:

1. Safety Promotion Programs for Elders

- Home-exercise promotions, which also help training physical strength of leg muscle groups for fall injury prevention.
- Home safety assessments and improvements for elders to prevent get hurt.
- Taking care of elders by visiting, regular phone greetings, meal services.
- To establish a home service and support system (Emergency Reporting System) that could provides necessary and in time help for elders when facing dangers alone.

2. Safety Promotion Programs for Students

- Assessment on Playground Safety by the elementary school students. Education trainings for students to better adopt proper safety knowledge, attitudes and behaviors and to further discover and improve unsafe places in schools.
- Holding “Bicycle License Issuance Program” to educate juniors cycling safety and traffic rules.
- Promote International Safe School Program.
- Promote water activity safety, and conduct basic self-saving and drowning-prevention skill trainings.

3. Leisure Activity Environment Safety Promotion Program

- Assess parks, hiking trails safety and report to relevant departments for improvements and repairing if dangerous places are spotted and ensure people doing leisure activities have a safe environment.

4. Road Traffic Safety Promotion Program

- Assess sidewalks and bypasses safety and report to relevant departments for repairing and improvements.
- Promotion pedestrian priority program to build the Pedestrian-Friendly environment

5. Work and Shopping Places Joint Safety Promotion Program

Set up joint cooperation ties between shopping places in the community and also provide relevant safety promotion information to notice the customer when they are shopping.

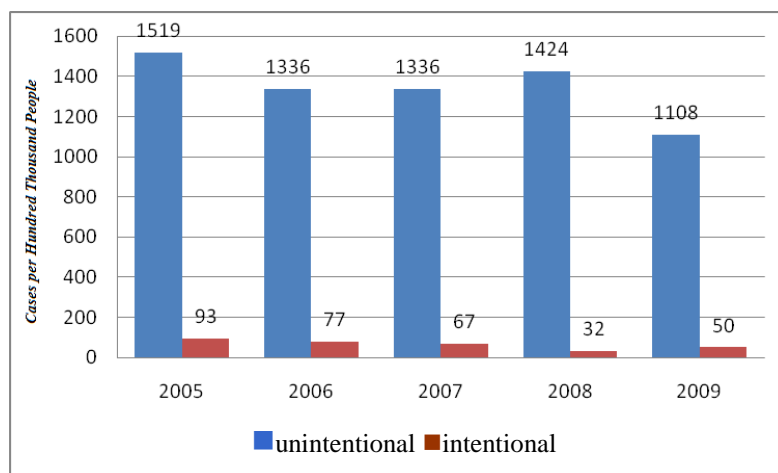

According to vital statistics of Department of Health, Taipei City Government, from 2005 to 2008, the unintentional injury death rate of Neihu District had dropped from 13.77 to 12.40 per hundred thousand people. While in 2009, the mortality rate raised to 15.34 due to road traffic injury and drowning.

Between 2005 and 2009, the intentional injury (suicide) death rate was with a wavy motion, but showed a sliding trend.

The number of intentional and unintentional injury cases between 2005 and 2009 showed a dropping trend overall.



In terms of unintentional injury, three major injury types were: road traffic, injury caused by cutting, striking, or caught in between objects and fall. According to the statistics, male had higher occurrence rate than female. The 15-to-24-year-old population is the majority of the high-risk group.

As for intentional injury, female had higher occurrence rate than male. The 25-to-44-year-old population is the majority of the high-risk group.
