Safety Promotion Programs

By age group, injury type and environment

(Attachment: representative photos of safety promotion activities)

Children 0-14 years:

- Education activities on facial features protection in kindergartens
- “Making Friends with Pets” Project aiming at preventing pet-related injuries
- *Little Hands Holding Big Hands* campaign to cultivate children’s safety consciousness and to use their influence to change adults’ way of behaviors



Young 15 to 24 years:

- Preventative Intervention measures for students on sports injuries to modify school playground and rectify sports facilities
- Emergency evacuation drills for students to train their skills of coping with fire, earthquake and other unexpected events
- Red Cross training to equip students with first aid skills as well as responsibility to help others.
- “Big Classroom for Safety Education” project, engaging in various special education activities such as designing safety education acts played all by students to build a model to influence peer students’ safety awareness



Middle-aged 25 to 64 years:

- Gas safety inspection which covers the whole community to identify potential safety problems and keep track for rectification.
- Traffic safety commitment activities and propaganda work to disseminate traffic laws and regulations
- Intervention activities on exercise for community residents to promote scientific, safe and fun exercise
- Reinforcement of security devices in the community such as surveillance facilities and access control systems as well as forces like community patrol teams, etc.





More than 65 years old

- Handing out bath mats to households with elderly people to prevent falling
- "30 Seconds Moving Rules" specially designed for elderly people's physical characteristics
- Safety & Health Speed Dial project to provide round all-day emergency aid service
- "5 Deliveries" Project (deliveries of care, nutrition, support, meals and entertainment)





Preventative intervention projects targeting high-risk groups

- Rehabilitation training for those who suffer from stroke-induced complications
- Rain Man by Our Side (From the Oscar-winning movie Rain Man) project, encouraging volunteers to make friends with the handicapped, to help them establish confidence in life and to create a friendly environment of loving and caring for them; opened Location Based Service (LBS) for the cell phones of all its student members, to prevent lost cases in advance.
- Workers' Home set up with help from labor unions, functional government departments and representative workers and designed for improving migrant workers' safety status
