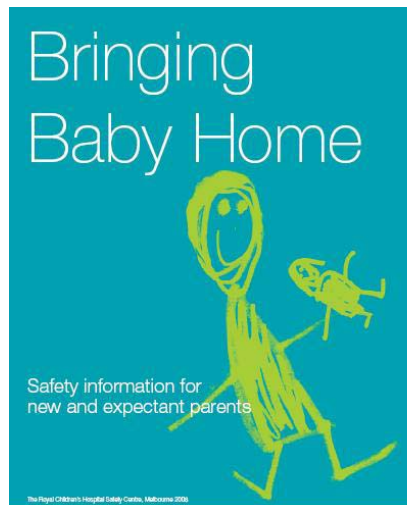


The Bringing Baby Home Kit

Aims to promote safety information for new parents.

Building on the huge success of the existing fact sheets we presented a new and exciting format specifically targeting expectant parents. An A4 colour booklet with a collection of the existing fact sheets in additions to two new topics, to fulfil the high proportion of the requests for information and resources received in the Safety Centre about planning for a baby.



This new resource enables parents to be informed in a highly accessible format about choosing for safety, providing a safe environment and safe home practices, the standards symbol, legislative requirements and also making the right choice for nursery furniture and car seats.

New topics include information on babysitting and childcare from the Office of the Child Safety Commissioner.

There are 64,000 new births per year in Victoria; at least half of these are first time births. These resources are being distributed to expectant parents attending maternity hospitals/birthing centres or community education classes such as ante-natal, childbirth education or obstetric physiotherapy classes as well as maternal and child health first parents groups.
