1. * Is the multi-storey car park painted in pale colours internally and equipped with good lighting?
2. * Is the car park well maintained, clean and free from litter and scrap?
3. * Are there signs at the entrance where it clearly states who owns or manages the car park?
4. * Is the positioning of signs in the car park unambiguous, with a clear indication of which are rented or visitors' parking places?
5. * Are the emergency exits free and clearly indicated with signs?
6. Are the doors/gates of the car park resistant and well-lit, taking into consideration the situation and vulnerability of the gates?
7. Are there no more than the minimum number of gates and exits necessary for purposes of evacuation?
8. Are the rented parking lots in the car park separate from the visitors' parking lots?
9. Are the corridor doors fitted with windows?
10. Is an electronic pass system or other equivalent system for entry to the multi-storey car park in use?
11. Are regular controls made for graffiti and other damage?
12. Is graffiti cleaned up and damage repaired within a time period that has been previously stipulated?
13. If the multi-storey car park is large. Is it divided into smaller units (sectioned)?
14. Are there car cages (secure lots) in the car park?
15. Have the car cages (secure lots) been approved and equipped with the correct type of lock, taking into consideration the vulnerability of the lots?
16. Does the owner of the property make regular checks of the car cages to ensure that storage of inflammable or explosive substances or similar items takes place in accordance with current regulations.
