1. * Is the car park well lit?
2. * Is the car park well maintained, and free from rubbish and scrap?
3. * Is the entire car park observable from residential housing or a nearby main road or is deficient natural surveillance compensated for by technical surveillance?
4. * Is the positioning of signs in the car park unambiguous, with a clear indication of which are rented or visitors' parking places?
5. Are there signs that exhort car owners to empty their cars?
6. Are there motion detectors that regulate lighting?
7. Has the number of entrances and exits been minimized?
8. Does the car park have clear boundaries?
9. Are there signs that clearly state who owns or manages the car park?
10. Are the gates of the garage equipped with the right locks, taking into consideration the position of the gates?
11. Are the rows of garages separated?
12. Are the garage doors well lit?
13. Are the car park company/parking lot attendants or others, e.g. volunteers, involved in working to decrease crime in the car park?
14. Is a steering wheel lock on offer when a parking lot is rented?
