

# Maizidian Community



Name: **Maizidian Community**

## Community Description

Located in Chaoyang District, Maizidian Community is bounded by east fourth ring road on the east and east third ring road on the west, adjacent to Agriculture Exhibition Hall Road and Chaoyang Park South Road on the south, and connected to airport expressway side road on the north. It covers an area of 6.8 square kilometers with 35,103 permanent residents, 10,900 migrants and 7,848 foreigners.

Maizidian Community was set up in 1988 with the connective location between town and country. There are four distinctive characteristics of economic development layout in the region: First, it contains Lufthansa Business Center composed of top-grade restaurants, hotels, office buildings, shopping malls and other modern services facilities with Lufthansa Center as the core; Second, it is home to the ongoing construction of Third Embassy District in Beijing, including the constructed Embassy of Israel, Embassy of Malaysia, Embassy of the Brunei

Darussalam, etc., the official residences of Japanese and Malaysian Ambassadors, German Embassy Apartment and German Primary School, and the constructing and planning Embassy of the United States of America, Embassy of German, Embassy of South Korea, Embassy of France, Embassy of Singapore, etc. Third, it comprises Chaoyang Park surrounded by top-class foreign residential areas. Chaoyang Park, the largest urban park in Asia, covers an area of 3.2 square meters. Overseas visitors account for 40% of its annual tourism reception. The top-grade mansion group around Chaoyang Park such as Bihuju, Boyajuan, Liangmamingju, etc. is one of neighborhoods for the foreign elite in Beijing. Fourth, it is facilitated with the National Agriculture Exhibition Hall, one of the large-scale international exhibition centers in Beijing. Every year 40% exhibitions and visitors come from overseas. In a word, Maizidian Community has rich foreign resources, proper population structure, complete infrastructure and enthusiastic support to community construction. With those advantaged characteristics, it is the earliest residential area for foreigners. Permanent foreign population accounts for 20% of the total permanent population in the community.

Economy enjoys high growth in Maizidian and per capita income of urban households in the region is comparatively high. According to the Statistics by the end of 2004, its regional GDP per capital is 12 times of the national level and 4 times of average level in Beijing. With the stable social order, advantaged investment environment and huge market potentials, Maizidian Community has attracted famous multinational corporations such as Microsoft, Sony, Epson, etc. and one third of MNCs and foreign invested companies settled in the region.

### **Community Structure**

Maizidian Community Office is the administrative division of Chaoyang District People's Government. Its main functions include regional development coordination, professional management supervision, public service organization and community construction guidance. It comprises 90 members made up of officers and staff from related service institutions and sets up Sector Offices of City Construction Management, Labor and Social Security, Public Security Comprehensive Management, Judicial Intermediation, Social Course Development, Civil Administration, Finance, Labor Union, Supervision, Women's Federation, Party Affairs, etc.

Maizidian Community is divided into five residential areas and five neighborhood committees, the executive arm of residents' self-rule with members voted by residents themselves to exercise the self-governance for each neighborhood under the guidance of Community Office and in accordance with the *Organic Law of the Residents' Committee*.

**The program covers the following safety promotion activities:**

**For the age group**

**Children 0—14 years**

Community Health Care Station formed " Child Injury Prevention and Control Team" and regularly organized children's parents to attend lectures on "Child Growth and Incidental Injury Prevention", " Chinese and Foreign Children Learning Safety", "Child Domestic Fall Prevention", "Animal Bites Prevention", "Medicine Use Safety" and so on.

- Lecture on scientific feeding and children safety were arranged for parents with children within age 0-3. To organize children's parents to hold activities with the topic of *Early Childhood Education, Surrounded by Safety* for the

popularization of safety knowledge such as infants education, children accidental injuries prevention, etc.

- Setting up “Children Safety Education and Training Base” and making safety education part of teaching courses. When driving out by private cars, parents should arrange proper seat and wear seatbelt for their children and tell them not to pay behind the car.
- Office of the Project of Safe Community Construction edited the manual comprising comprehensive safety knowledge with the aim of promoting child and home safety. Over 40,000 manuals have been distributed to residents. The manual covers child safety, food safety, traffic safety, home safety, fire prevention and self rescue and so on.

### **Youth 15-24 years:**

In 2004, in order to figure out causes of students’ injuries, we initiated surveys in Zaoying Primary and High Schools targeting at “the most unsafe places, the high-risk environment, etc.” with the participation of 300 students; we traced records of accidental injuries attendances at community hospitals; we made random sample in residential areas to find out causes of students’ injuries. The results show that traffic risk ranks first among risk factors outside campus and sports risk ranks first among risk factors within campus. Therefore safety programs were formulated as below:

- To implement sustainable “Safe Angel Program” among students. To conduct safety knowledge competitions in forms of meetings, lectures, demonstrations, onsite simulation drills, etc.
- To install safety signs at crucial road section, safety caution boards at school gates, playgrounds and teaching places. To guide students to cross street safely after class.
- To organize students to take traffic safety education classes at traffic safety training center.
- To arrange emergency rescue drills and learn knowledge of first aids such as cardiopulmonary resuscitation, band enswathing, conveying, etc. Children learn and practice rescue breathing and cardiopulmonary resuscitation on mannequins.
- To launch safety educational activities at Community Service Center mainly in forms of traffic signs competition targeting at children in summer holiday

### **Adults 25-64 years**

According to data analysis of Community Health Care Stations medical records: In terms of clients’ age, occupations and causes of injuries, accidental injury was most common in retirees within age 56-65 and migrant workers who were also identified as vulnerable groups. This situation was in relation to the jobs of those migrant workers. One of important reasons for the highest injury rate of migrant workers was that most of them did not receive strict occupational trainings and safety education.

Safety Program was mapped out in accord with data analysis above:

- Safety knowledge column was set up in *Maizidian Weekly* to raise people's awareness of safety.
- To organize trainings for social units, schools, kindergartens, residents and migrant worker, etc. in order to enhance people's awareness of injury prevention and to promote knowledge of scientific prevention.
- To hold various lectures and activities for safe promotion targeting at youth and the middle-aged such as holding accidental disease rescue drills, first aid drills, driving safety simulation training and a series of talks on health, fire control safety, home use medicine, minor crime prevention, electric safety, traffic accident rescue
- To establish first aid system in community

### **Elderly above 65 years:**

In 2004, neighborhood committee conducted a survey on elderly safe in the region. There were 4,472 elderly people above 60 years including 313 above 80 years and 3672 within age 60-79, and 505 living in the empty nest.

With the aim of solving difficulties and problems of the elderly, we launched a series of activities as below:

- To conduct consultation on seasonal diseases and psychological health for the elderly and to organize the elderly to take part in the simulation demonstration of "Strangers Visiting Injury Prevention".
- To set up home sickbed for the elderly with the support of community health care station. To assign one volunteer for each empty nest family to help the elderly with inconvenience of mobility. To advocate activities of "Respecting and Helping the Elderly" such as establishing the partnership between community personnel and the elderly in empty nest. Volunteers do housework in the empty-nest families such as sweeping, brushing glasses, taking care of the elderly.
- "Silver Age Club" was set up with the facilities of reading center, recreation center, excising center, healing center, elderly rights protection station, and daytime care room and multi-function hall.
- Located at the high-grade mansion, "Golden Sun Club" was equipped with ping-pong table, chess tables and chairs, the elderly class and the elderly chatting room.
- To make free health examination and health records for the elderly above 60 years and to invite experts to conduct lectures on health, health care and rights protection law for the elderly. About 20,000 RMB was collected to install "Home First Aid Calling Machine " with one-year free service for 175 empty-nest families.

### **Prevention Programs that target high-risk environments**

## Home Safety

Neighborhood committee conducted survey and talks on home safety in order to have a clear picture of home safety status. The results show that most domestic injuries occurred in the daytime because among those staying at home at work time, most were the elderly, including the empty-nest elderly. First, gas is an important cause of injuries; second, if the elderly at home cannot receive timely aid when their diseases are taken bad, which is easy to cause death; third, improper electric use will cause fire outbreak. Therefore, neighborhood committee conducted a series of activities as below:

- To conduct mutual inspection and assistance in home safety with neighborhood and building as unit, to eradicate unsafe factors in gas and electric use. Over 1,200 residents were divided into 10 groups to take part in safety simulation training at Home Safety Training Class. Volunteers were also organized to take charge of community patrol.
- Policemen conduct renting basement inspection weekly, forbidden the use of gas and fire, reset electric lines, fire extinguishing equipments, emergency lights, safe entrance signs and other facilities
- A large-scale fire drill will be arranged on October 11<sup>th</sup> every year. To hold fire control safety onsite meeting timely and to implement fire control safety inspection incessantly.
- Safety caution notices were pasted on each floor of 103 buildings and 385 gates. To distribute fire control safety leaflets to each household and complete traffic marks on fire fighting observed passages. To organize residents to watch educational video of " Public Security Prevention and Control, " Traffic Accidents Cases", etc.
- Working group on Firecracker and Firework Inspection was formed during the Spring Festival to install more fire extinguishers at key places. The proposals namely *To Residents were* printed and distributed in community to tell residents about fire outbreak and injury prevention in burning firecracker and firework.
- Each neighborhood committee implements safety inspection to small-scale stores, hair salons, restaurants, KTV (Karaoke TV), bars and workshop one by one and puts up caution notices saying cases of fire outbreak.

## Traffic safety

Traffic safety ranks second in ten categories of injuries. The elderly is identified as the high-risk group in traffic safety and motor vehicle drivers are often in face with high-risk environments. Accordingly, works on traffic injury prevention were initiated as below:

- Traffic safety coordinators, security guards and appointed staff diverts traffic

flow at crossing roads, stations, main entrances and gates of primary and high schools. We completed the construction of 620 meters of traffic marks, 28 traffic signs and 10 speed-down sections.

- To establish Community Traffic Safety Training Center. There are road simulation demonstration CDs and teaching software developed specifically targeting at the elderly, children and other vulnerable groups. The center can make onsite simulation and multimedia demonstration of 14 types of traffic accidents in Beijing, 125 types of road wrong behaviors, 221 kinds of traffic signs and 51 kinds of traffic marks; In past two years, it had held 46 times trainings with over 2350 person-times for vehicle management personnel, drivers, the elderly and students.
- To post publicity notice at hotels, restaurants and other places. Service personnel remind customers of "Deterring Drinking While Driving and No Driving after Drinking". To hold roving exhibition on traffic safety knowledge and play science and education movies at construction sites.
- To import parking management company into community. In the way of bidding, Parking Management Company was settled in community to make records, safety examination and parking management for all cars in and out community.

### **Production Safety**

- Every year principals from 650 corporations in the regional sign the *Responsibility Book for Safe Production and Fire Control Safety Management* and *Responsibility Book for Public Security Comprehensive Management*, the implementation of "the department in charge being the department responsible" and "deny by one ticket" in safe production and comprehensive management.
- 3,461 people including artificial persons, managers and staff from 465 social units attended fire control evacuation and first aid lectures organized by fire control department and police stations. From June to July, 260 people including representatives of social units, members of neighborhood committee, residents and others were organized to visit public safety exhibitions.
- "Safety Knowledge Competition" and "Safety in My Heart" lecture were launched at construction sites, social units, neighborhood committees, hotels, restaurants, etc; art performances activities were held at social units, construction sites, Chaoyang Park and other places during "Safety Month".

### **Public Security**

- To establish the Regional Command Center for Comprehensive City Management and to integrate three important forces of public security, city management and public service, to install electronic supervisory systems at 31 major places of the community.
- To set up Maizidian Community Website and to open three service lines

around the clock.

- To implement awards system for community public security prevention and control. Awards funds were founded with 100,000 RMB transferred from Community Office. The *Measures for Public Security Prevention and Control Awards* was publicized and implemented in the whole community for honoring and awarding residents who made important contributions to public security of the community.

### **Programs aiming at “High-risk groups”**

#### **Programs aiming at the handicapped**

Since there was no hospital in the community, local residents and the handicapped were always encountered with difficulty in consulting a doctor. To solve this problem, Maizidian Community invested the construction of high standard and star-grade community health care stations for delivering quality medical services for residents and the handicapped. The stations also made health records for the elderly and the handicapped through conducting surveys on the disadvantaged group in the region.

#### **Outdoor Safety and Convenience for the Handicapped**

To minimize traffic inconvenience and occurrence of accidents and injuries, Maizidian Safe Community Promotion Committee adopted a series of measures to improve community facilities in order to effectively ensure the outdoor safety for the handicapped.

- To build blind tracks at public places and overpasses to ensure the safe passing of blind persons and other handicapped people.
- To reconstruct neighborhood committee and public service center and to install a set of non-obstacle facilities such as ramps, barriers that provide convenience for the handicapped.
- To pay attention to safety in public place during leisure activities and to equip two wheel chairs in each neighborhood for targeting at the incontinence of the handicapped.
- To set up “Loving Heart Supermarket” in residential districts targeting at the inconvenience of the handicapped in order to provide them with near door shopping service.
- To provide guidance for migrant workers through scientific and educational videos, safety trainings, publicity leaflets and so on targeting at the characteristics of migrants.

The data above shows that public security, traffic and production remained as the three major causes of injuries in past three years in Maizidian Community. The casualties in 2004 and 2005 have obviously reduced than that in 2003 before the inauguration of the project of Safe Community construction.
