3. Over the past 12 months, HYISCPC convened plenary session on a quarterly basis. There was no change to the way HYISCPC is funded.

Criteria 2 – Sustainable programs

4. Over the past 12 months, there were no significant changes to the working group, work emphasis and

work areas in HYISC, which still consisted of seven aspects: fire safety, home safety, road traffic safety, workplace safety, violence prevention, hygiene and health safety, and environmental safety.

5. Over the past 12 months, the success programs of HYISC were:

(1) Construction project of "Four Abilities" of fire prevention: HYISC widely promoted the construction of the "Four Abilities" which is "the fire alarm, evacuation, popularization of basic fire knowledge and fire protection. Stipulated the fire-fighting construction standards for crowded places and equipped simple and clear visual instructions for firefighting equipments. Conducted trainings on firefighting and personnel evacuation for social units each week.

Focused on strengthening the capacity of fire rescue in high-rise building. In June 2010, the Municipal Special Firefighting and Rescue Detachment united with Fire Department of Huaiyin District to organize a large-scale fire emergency rescue drill in high-rise building which included fire alarm, the primary firefighting, evacuation and professional rescue. About 200 people from social units, mass organizations and public security, public health, transportation and other government departments were organized to participate in these drills.

(2) Program for workplace occupational health protection: deeply carried out program for workplace occupational health protection by way of government supervision and actual operation by the enterprises, stipulated specific standards and regulations in the construction sites and in the production and operation areas for hazardous chemicals to ensure workers' health. In June 2010, the ILO occupational safety and health expert Richthofen, together with another three experts, visited HYISC to inspect the safe community building, gave high praise and expressed willingness to establish cooperation relationship.

(3) Road safety promotion program: adhered to the principle of "administering personnel, vehicle and road", conducted an activity named "Create a Community with More Civilized Traffic", organized the grassroots community and organizations to manage the drivers and vehicles of its region by categories and conducted safety publicity. The government funded RMB three million to build fast track isolation lairage for double carriage way in Huaiyin District, which significantly reduced the probability of car heads on collisions. The government also invested RMB 1.3 million to add signal lights, speed testing and video surveillance system at total 13 intersections along the main road to Jing Tenth West Road.

Criteria 3 – High risk groups & environments

6. Over the past 12 months, HYISC conducted the following works for the high risk groups/environments:

(1) Year 2010 is an important year for HYISC that HYISC developed and constructed projects quickly and successfully. During this year, up to 0.13 million people were relocated, accounting for 1/3 of total 0.38 million populations in HYISC. In 2010, the relocation is the high-risk environment faced by HYISC. So HYISC printed and distributed 20,000 "Relocation Safety Manual" which explained the safety cautions during relocation in detail to each household. The government organized a unified relocation,

selected qualified social enterprises and construction teams to conduct construction, which were governed and inspected by the monitoring group made up of members from different government departments. There was no personal injury throughout the relocation process.

(2) In respect of the safety interventions for the elderly, relying on the apartments for the elderly, we integrated the community resources to build activity room in apartments for the elderly; as a result, we provided the elderly with family-style services and ensured all-round safety. We set up services of home-based care for the aged and sent working staff to take care of and chat with the elderly at home, send the elderly to hospital and help them to bathe. We also tried to explore new ways for home care services to improve the living condition of the elderly, especially for those in extraordinarily straitened circumstances. We established Silver Talk Bar, which is a network platform for the elderly to mediate disputes and get spiritual comfort. The elderly can chat with each other here.

We launched the activity of “Month of Mental Health Report”. Experts and professors from Jinan University held lectures such as “Happy Old Age”, "The Psychological Adjustment of the Retired Elderly “and ” Measures to the Mental Health Problems of the Elderly”, which gained recognition in the community and had greatly improved the mental health for the elderly.

(3) In respect to the safety interventions for the disabled, we kept archives for "Rehabilitation for All", offered at-home services and created dedicated file for each disabled person. Currently, here are more than 5,200 disabled person have their own dedicated files. We investigated the needy families of severely disabled person and reported their situations to the upper authorities, subsidized low-income families with first and second disabled person following the policy of RMB 50 Yuan to each person of such families quarterly. We totally registered 958 severely disabled persons and reported their situations to the upper authorities. We offered free health check for 60 women from low-income families; and offered free gynecological examinations to women aged below 55 from needy families by uniting with Zhenai Women’s Hospital.

(4) In respect to the safety interventions for adolescents, we strengthened the violence prevention and intervention in schools and kindergartens. The government funded more than RMB 2 million for 64 schools and kindergartens to employ full-time safeguards and install the video surveillance system. We also carried out large publicity activity, widely publicized school violence prevention.

Criteria 4– Injury data

7. Over the past 12 months, with the major help from Huaiyin Hospital and its affiliated community health stations, and with the assistance from the clinics in schools, kindergartens and enterprises, we recorded and analyzed the injury data in Huaiyin District. Totally 118,723 people were covered in the monitoring system, 1626 injuries occurred, the injury rate is 1.37%. According to the accident information collected and analyzed by the safety supervision, firefighting, traffic police, construction and other government departments, there were 211 security incidents and 12 people died in such incidents.

Criteria 5– Evaluation

8. Over the past 12 months, we focused on the evaluation of the following programs:

(1) Road safety promotion program: according to the analysis of the incident data, we found that some municipal construction had affected the traffic safety, mainly included that the road greenbelt was not set reasonably and some sidewalks were not paved with blind road. In order to solve these problems, the road traffic group has built archives of hidden dangers for the survey results of the road traffic and recorded 37 hidden dangers which are now at the adjustment and construction phase by the District Government.

(2) Workplace safety promotion program: evaluated the occupational health protection for the workers and found that the construction sites were relatively lack of labor protection,, such as the helmets were not in compliance with the standards and some builders didn't wear the safety belts. Currently, HYISC is inspecting the quality of the labor protection products and supervising the training for the workers in more than 200 construction sites in Huaiyin District.

(3) Home safety promotion program: we evaluated the home safety problems from 130,000 relocation residents. By door-to-door survey and establishment of suggestion box, we collected the recommendations from the residents and found the major problem the relocation residents facing was the home safety of moving from the old bungalows to buildings. Some residents did not understand the safety of residential buildings, especially fire prevention in buildings, due to the relocation changed the living environment. HYISC has planned to start implementing high-rise residential fire safety projects in 2011 to solve the above problem.

Criteria 6– Networks

9. In the past 12 months, HYISC mainly participated in the following safe community network activity:

(1) From March 22 to 27, delegation of HYISC, total 6 people, participated in the 19th International Safe Community Conference held in South Korean.

(2) From November 18 to 19, delegation of HYISC participated in the National Safe Community Building Conference held in Chongqing, China.

(3) In July and September, HYISC sent two batches of personnel to conduct the onsite evaluation and acceptance for 12 safe communities in Dalian, China.

(4) As one of the four Safe Community Support Centers in China, HYISC has guided the construction of 82 safety communities successively, organized three classes to train safety community standards and construction methods, training more than 700 cadreman for the safe community construction. In 2010,

HYSIC has received 186 study tours from China, widely disseminated the safe community concept.

10. Opportunities and challenges:

Year 2011 is a year with full development and constructions for HYISC, there were up to 200 construction sites and about 0.15million migrant workers in Huaiyin District. In addition, with the high-rise building construction speeding up, high-rise building fire protection becomes a new challenge. In June 2010, since the opening of the Beijing-Shanghai High-speed Railway, the annual average motor vehicles passing through Huaiyin District will be increased from 80 million times to 0.17 billion times, so there will heavy pressure on traffic safety. In 2011, HYISC will focus on the following four promotion programs to solve the above problem:

1. Construction safety promotion program: to implement management system, mobilize the whole society to supervise and manage the construction sites and appoint related responsible persons in township and community. To strength the training for the builders on the construction site and to improve their safety quality.

2. Safety promotion program for the migrant workers. to establish mass organizations made up of migrant workers with the principle of self-management, self-service and self-education, and to solve the safety issues the migrant workers facing in their job and daily life.

3. High-rise building fire protection projects. To formulate higher standards of fire protection for the high-rise building under construction, requiring the establishment of an evacuation room with escape cordon on each floor. To give up flammable insulation material, publicize the knowledge to escape in high-rise buildings for all the people and hold more trainings for the property management departments in high-rise building to improve the evacuation and firefighting capabilities.

4. Road safety promotion program. We will continue conducting the activity named “Create a Community with More Civilized Traffic”, strengthening education and training for the drivers by relying on the grassroots units and strengthening the management and examinations of motor vehicles. We will form full-time traffic management teams in the railway stations and make effort to traffic dispersion and traffic control to prevent traffic accidents.
