5: Please list at least three success stories from your program over the past 12 months?

5-1: The program of traffic safety to elders—there were several neighborhoods (XinGuang, Fushan, Caiguan, and the center of Social Bureau) joined together in participation the program of traffic safety for elders. Street broadcasting and prizes were supplied from Social Bureau, and the volunteer workers and light snacks were from the office of the head-neighborhood. The program was accomplished smoothly.

5-2 The pathway between library and the Zouying junior high school—we invited the students and faculty of Zouying junior high school to adopt the path, which connects the library to the station of Metro railway transportation. The major duty for the program was cutting weeds, planting shrubs and cleaning trash. The fund was from the Environmental Bureau for the environmental preserving purpose.

5-3 The Home Safety program for elders and women—we gathered the youth from Kaohsiung Medical University. There were 50 youth volunteers divided into five groups to manage two street sections. Each group had the responsibility (providing information of living safety, greeting, ..etc) for visiting and calling on the households, which the elders and women live along.

6: Over the past 12 months, please specify what high risk groups/environments has your ISC focused on and details of outcomes achieved?

6-1: Home Safety program for elders—an opened computer class for elders, and in the class we taught the elders how to use internet to learn and receive more information about the safety.

6-2: Signs on dangerous intersection—there were several traffic incidents on main intersections (such as Zeng-zi Rd. and Wen-ling Rd.), we encourage local residents to join the meeting and make the improvements. We also invite the city

counselors to statement and speak for the issue. During the past year, the street sections have put more warning signs and started to set as one-way-traffic. Till now we are still working hard to make the dangerous street sections safer, and we believe there are more duties to do to make a better quality and safe community for living.

There were no analyzed crime data reported near by the community. The injury reports majorly came from local fire department, Zouying Armed Force Hospital, Kaohsiung Union Hospital. Partial data were collected from the announcement of City government

8-1 Counseling meeting: the meeting focused on the safety for women and elders. The youth volunteers take home visits every Tuesday, and they also precede evaluation and problems discussion and solution.

8-2 Duty discussion: the meeting was scheduled in every three months, and purposed for duty arrangement and problem discussion.

Final comments:

10: Over the past 12 months, what have been some of the biggest challenges to your ISC and what steps have you taken to address these?

- Traffic Safety—the construction and improvement of Zeng-Zi Rd.
- School Safety—we encourage the local residents to join the safety promotion project and meeting through the youth and several literatures. Therefore, the pathway between the library to Zouying Junior High School was adapted from local residents, and now the pathway is clean and safe in the night with lights.
- Intentional injury prevention—we cooperated with city government. Firstly collected the information of “how to preventing the intentional injury” and then we cooperated with psychiatric department of city government. The general monitoring and screening was taken 3 months for a period of time, and the follow-up was also collaboration with government.

11: Over the past 12 months, what have been some of the biggest opportunities for your ISC and what steps have you taken to sustain them?

During May to Nov., we managed the Workshop of Safe Community Development in Kaohsiung; eight administrative districts were invited, and eighteen communities joined. The workshops were successfully achieved and safe community networks were completely promoted.
