3-b:With the budget provided by Environmental Protection Bureau, Chiayi County, the low-carbon community plan is promoted. In this plan, the safety education is included, in which community volunteers are taught to carry out relevant protection measures when the park is under construction.

Criteria 2 – Sustainable programs

4: Over the past 12 months have there been any changes to your working groups/priority areas?

Yes

4-1: Hsinkang Township is a town with serious aging population problems. Therefore, in the process of promotion, elders safety has always been one of our primary foci, and elders safety issues always get full support in our community.

4-1-1: 24 elders over the age of 60 participated in the research of slowing down the aging of muscle strength conducted by Department of Physical Education, National Chiayi University.

4-1-2: Research findings are expected to be compiled and published in June, 2011.

4-2:From the injury data, it is found that campus injury cases increased by 191 in number in 2010.

Therefore, in 2011, solutions regarding promoting school safety will be put forward.

4-2-1: In 2010, the injuries that took place in Gu-Ming Elementary School was regularly mentioned by teachers to prevent possible similar injuries, and cases in art classes are obviously fewer afterwards.

5-1: Expand promotion areas: Through the sharing of Hsinkang Safe Community, Nan-lun and Bei-lun

Villages are willing to take part in the promotion of safe community.

5-2:School safety:

5-2-1:The cutting injury in Gu-Ming Elementary raised the attention of school faculty and staff. The School Safety Section asked teachers to focus on promoting the correct use of cutter art knives.

Injury cases decreased from 6 to 4 in number.

5-2-2:Fu-Xing Elementary School is willing to assist in injury surveillance at school.

6-1:Elders Safety:

6-1-1 Tumbling prevention class for the elders: increased from one to four classes.

6-1-2 Cooperated with the Department of Physical Education, National Chiayi University, in the scientific experiment to look for ways to slow down the aging of muscle strength. The research findings are expected to be published in June, 2011.

7: Over the past 12 months, have you analyzed any injury/crime data?

Yes

7-1: Fu-Xing Elementary School Health Center joined the Injury Monitor Network.

7-2: From the data of accident injuries, Fu-Xing Elementary School has high risks in campus safety. Therefore, the attention is shifted to Fu-Xing Elementary School in 2011 campus safety.

8-1: Campus Safety: Campus safety meeting was held on March 24th, with other schools in Singang Township invited to join the meeting.

8-1-1: Proposed to increase one more school in the injury data collection. After the meeting, Fu-Xing Elementary School agreed to join.

8-1-2: To strengthen the concept of campus safety in every school, relevant safety promotions are carried out before summer vacation, in Fu-Xing Elementary School, Gu-Ming Elementary

School and An-he Elementary School, which was completed respectively on May 12, June 9 and July 2.

8-2: Agriculture/work safety: Heat stroke prevention is carried out on a larger scale.

8-2-1: In addition to Chong-Chung and Gu-Ming Villages, prevention promotion is targeted at high risk villages (one accident in 2007): The promotion is held in Ban-Tou Village on Aug 11 and 12.

9-b-1-1: On June 28 and 29, 2010, we participated “2010 International Safe Community Certification and Promotion Plan Workshop” – on how to develop international safe community: understand methods of injury monitoring and how to carry out.

9-b-1-2: On Oct 2, 2010, we participated “Elders Injury Prevention and Safety Promotion Seminar and Press Conference”: Community partners have experience exchanges and sharing with partners in other network, to further understand the importance of elder injury prevention.

9-c-1: On July 1, 2010, we participated “Northern Support Center, Taiwanese Safe Community Promotion Center, Safe Community Seminar,” in which we shared how Hsinkang Township carried out the safe community program, and learned from other partners’ experiences in safety promotion.

The biggest challenge is the lack of administrative work force. We have been looking for the help of volunteers through committee member meeting and administration meeting.

11-1: The opportunity to cooperate with the academia: Under the leadership of board directors, the safe community organization carried out many seminars to encourage citizens to participate relevant research.

11-2: Look for budget for community members' participation. This allows the community citizens to have subsidy support.
