

Professor Mirjana Milankov, MD, MSc, PhD

Graduated from the Medical Faculty of the University of Novi Sad (1979), and got a master's degree at the same University (1985). Continued her studies and specialized in social medicine and became a specialist in social medicine in organizing health care (1988). She got her doctor's degree after successfully defending her doctoral thesis "Socio - medical aspects of traumatism in children" and became a PhD in medical sciences (1991). She was promoted into a scientific research fellow and researcher and became a senior scientific fellow (1992). The Ministry of Health of Republic Serbia nominated her as the head doctor (1999). At the Faculty of preschool teacher's education in Subotica she became a professoress and got her professorate (2009).

She was working as a MD at the Health Center in Vrbas. As a specialist of social medicine she also worked in the Institute for Public Health in Novi Sad, where she was the director, and the Clinical Center of Vojvodina as the headmistress of the Polyclinic.

She has written a few monographs so far: 'Traumatism among Children', 'Safe Community – Life Without injuries', 'Safe Children in the Safe Community'. As a co-author she has worked on 12 more monographs. She published and presented 96 professional and scientific works about injuries and injury prevention in her homeland and abroad.

As a researcher she took part in numerous scientific and research projects and became the leader and supervisor of the project 'Safe Community' in Republic Serbia since 2001. Translating the SC Weekly News into Serbian language.

She is the founder and president of: the National Center for Injury Prevention and Safety Promotion Novi Sad (2004), the South Eastern Europe Safe Community Network and Affiliate Safe Community Support Centre of WHO CC Community Safety Promotion (2009).

She was Chairlady Organizing Committee 1st Regional Southeastern Europe Conference on Safe Communities in Novi Sad (2009). She is member of Scientific Committee, Safe Community Conferences in Bergen, Cali, Suwon, Reykjavík, Sibenik.

She is member of: International Society for Violence and Injury Prevention, International Safe Community Support Team.
