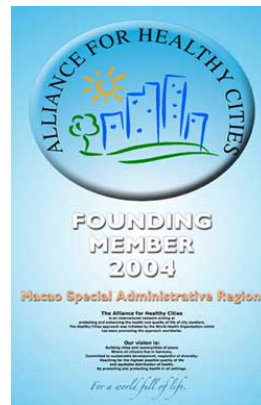

Healthy City – 6 working groups

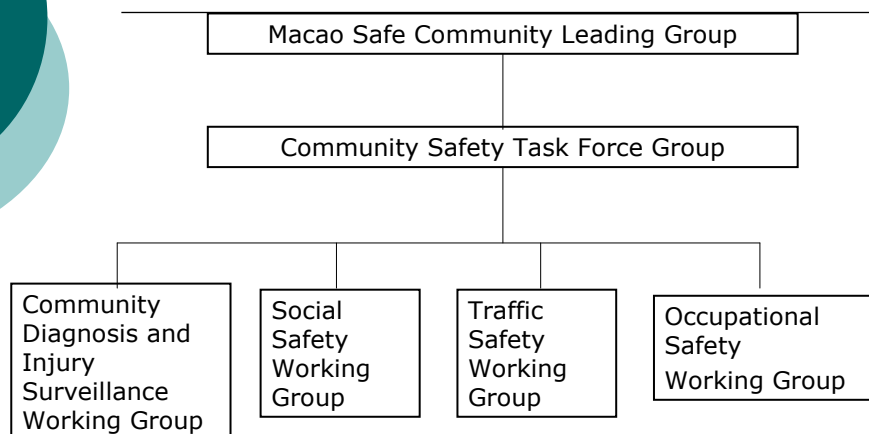
- Health services

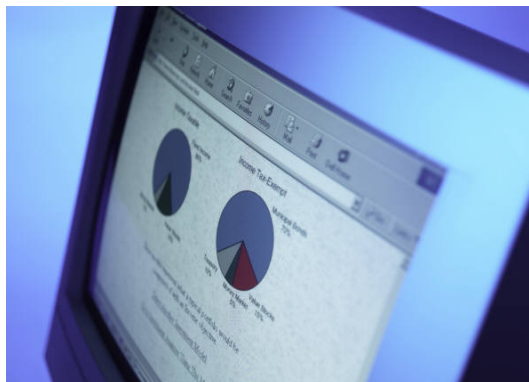
Major challenges faced by Macao

Number of Deaths by Types of Injuries (2005 & 2006)

	2005		2006	
Domestic & Daily Live Injuries	44	25.3%	18	11.8%
Road Traffic Injuries	21	12.1%	19	12.4%
Working Injuries	20	11.5%	6	3.9%
Interpersonal Violence	5	2.9%	9	5.9%
Suicide	67	38.5%	72	47.1%
Others	17	9.8%	29	19%
Total	174	100.0%	153	100.0%
